Volunteer **Opportunities**

Baby & Me Advocate

These programs are long-term, patient care courses focused on one-on-one mentoring and education with incentives for goals met. Baby & Me Advocates equip patients to be the best parents they can be, whether they choose to parent or make an adoption plan. Patient documentation done via Electronic Medical Records (EMR). Time: 2 to 4 hours per week. <u>Requirements:</u> good computer skills, compassionate heart for women facing unplanned pregnancies, integrity, and excellent people skills.

Sexual Risk Avoidance Advocates

Sexual Risk Avoidance (SRA) Advocates work with patients who desire to have integrity in all areas of their lives, including their sexuality. Patient documentation done via EMR. Time: 2 hours per week. <u>Requirements:</u> good computer skills, compassionate heart for women in need of healthy life choices, integrity, and excellent people skills.

Follow-Up Specialist

Provides ongoing support during the patient's pregnancy through phone calls, asking questions to learn how patient is doing, and providing additional referrals, if needed. These volunteers give 4 hours of service a month. <u>Requirements:</u> good computer and phone skills, integrity, and compassionate heart for women facing unplanned pregnancies. Duties can be performed when the Center is closed.

Advancement Team

Helps with mailings, copying, and other administrative support duties. May also help organize and execute fundraising events. Time: Variable. <u>Requirements:</u> integrity, organizational skills, and a heart for the ministry.

Abortion Recovery Specialist

Guides people who have personally experienced abortion through Bible studies such as *Save One* and *Her Choice to Heal* as they seek forgiveness and healing. Time commitment varies. <u>Requirements:</u> compassionate heart for people who have experienced abortion, willingness to lead study on a weekly basis, meeting one-on-one, in a group setting, or online helping lead people to healing and forgiveness, integrity, and excellent people and interpersonal communication skills. **Board of Directors**

The Board consists of volunteers who have vision and passion for the ministry. These individuals meet as a group and provide oversight and accountability for the CEO and set policies. Board members are expected to support the Center financially and to take part in fundraising and donor development. Time commitment varies. <u>Requirements:</u> ability to attend meetings and events, a heart for ministry and non-profits, integrity, and authenticity.

Prayer Team

Ensures that all the Center's programs, volunteers, staff, and patients are covered in prayer at least weekly. Specific prayer requests are emailed to team members. <u>Requirements:</u> a strong prayer life, a heart for the ministry, and commitment to checking email regularly.

Building, Grounds, & Maintenance Team

Help the inside and outside of the Center maintain a professional appearance through pulling weeds, sweeping the parking lot, and small repair jobs. Time commitment varies, depending on Center's needs. <u>Requirements:</u> integrity, a heart for the ministry, enjoy working with your hands, carpentry and maintenance skills, and/or working outdoors.
