Monica's Journey to Joy

"Six years ago, a former boyfriend kidnapped me. He raped and nearly killed me," 24-year-old Monica told her Advocate. "I became pregnant from that incident, and I had an abortion. Possibly being pregnant has brought all that back, and I'm kind of a wreck."

Although her circumstances were not at all the same, our patient's emotions were running high. She had strong support for carrying to term – her boyfriend and several family members. Yet, she said emotionally she wasn't sure she could handle being pregnant. Finances were another primary concern as

she worked a minimum wage job. She was undecided as to the outcome of her pregnancy.

As they awaited the results of her pregnancy test, Monica and her Advocate discussed faith. The young woman had no church home and wasn't very interested in finding one. "I used to attend, but I've been hurt by the church and supposed Christians," Monica said. "People can be very judgmental. I stepped away from church but not from my faith. I do pray and I do believe in God. After what happened, I struggle at times, but I do try to maintain a faith walk."

Her Advocate encouraged her to try different churches and noted that people can be flawed, but that God is not. She encouraged our young patient to read the Bible and to continue praying. She also suggested she consider finding a counselor.

Her pregnancy test positive, Monica received an ultrasound, which revealed she was 12 weeks along. Her eyes widened and she appeared surprised at the image, the Advocate noted. Afterwards, when the two reconvened in the consulting room, the Advocate asked Monica what she thought about what she saw.

"I never realized I was that far along. The ultrasound makes it all so real – I actually have a baby inside me!"

When asked if she was still undecided about the outcome of her pregnancy, Monica said, "Oh no – I'll be carrying and I'll likely parent. I believe my boyfriend will be very happy."

She met with our Early KinCare Pregnancy Resource Coordinator to sign up for Medicaid and register for the Baby & Me Program. The Resource Coordinator also persuaded Monica to meet with a counselor, who will come to True Care to see the young woman. As she steps into this journey of motherhood, we believe she'll also be stepping onto a more positive path for her life, receiving the help and encouragement, as well as the education she needs.

Resources for our Patients by Cheryl Flores

There is a common saying "You can lead a horse to water but you can't make it drink." I think of this saying often as I minister to the women who enroll in the Early KinCare Pregnancy Resource Program.

The purpose of the Early KinCare (EKC) Pregnancy Resource Program is to help prevent learning disabilities and delays by assisting the mother to receive the best care she can and by connecting her early in her pregnancy with the appropriate resources. Women who come to True Care and have a positive pregnancy test are offered the opportunity to enroll in the program. She agrees to receive

follow up calls throughout her pregnancy. These

calls are done, on average, once a month. Unfortunately, some of my clients are very hard to reach and to stay in touch with. I text, call and leave messages but often get no response.

Take Darcie, for instance. I enrolled her in EKC during the summer of 2017. We kept in touch at first, but from October

"She sat across from me, devastated and lost." through December I was unable to reach her. I left messages and texted her, but no response. Then in January Darcie popped in to True Care and wanted to see me. She was less than 30 days from her due date. Her

phone number had changed, which was one of the reasons we lost touch.

Darcie lost her job unexpectedly due to flooding at her place of employment. She had a big blow up with her boyfriend and they broke up. She sat across from me, devastated and lost. "I am in a place I cannot afford. I have no money, no job. I don't even have enough money for toiletries. I do not know what to do, but I remembered that you might be able to help me. I am sorry to just drop in on you like this." We talked about where to go for help with emergency assistance and who could help with toiletries. I was able to comfort and pray for her. She felt relieved that help was available.

You may not be able to make a horse drink the water, but, sometimes, if all else fails, you can show them where the water is.



The Early KinCare Pregnancy Resource Program is open to all True Care patients. The program is funded by the Healthy Birth and Infant Brains Foundation and officially began in January 2013. During this time Cheryl has enrolled 721 patients in the program and made more than 3,582 patient contacts. She has completed 652 Medicaid applications. So far, 505 babies have been born to women who enrolled in the program.
