She knew that familiar feeling...but it couldn't be...she was still breastfeeding. She could not push the looming thought out of her head until later that night she decided to take an at home test. The blood drained from her face and it felt like she was numb all over. Positive. Acacia rushed into the bedroom and fell into her husband's arms sobbing. Dave, who was nothing if not a realist, said We cannot afford another kid. I think you should get an abortion. We need to take care of the children we have already." She was speechless. Part of her felt like he was right and the other part was devastated to think about ending this pregnancy in that way. He continued to pressure her make an appointment until she finally succumbed. She scheduled an abortion in Colorado for the next week, but decided to go to True Care in the meantime. Acacia went alone because she knew Dave would try to talk her out of it. She could not bring herself to look at the ultrasound screen, she knew what she would see and her heart could not handle it. The scared young mom had many questions for the nurse about the procedure. Would she be able to care for her children while she was going hrough it? The compassionate nurse lovingly and truthfully answered her questions in a professional manner. Acacia left that day with the intention of having an abortion the following week.

Over the next 2 months, the nurses and follow-up specialists tried to reach Acacia with no success. One quiet day at the office, True Care's CEO was sitting at her desk thinking she was alone, when one of our lovely follow up volunteers came bounding into the room with the biggest smile of pure joy washing over her face. "She's going to parent! She's going to parent! She chose to continue her pregnancy! She is having a little girl!" The two women laughed and cried and praised God together for giving Acacia the courage to choose life for her baby, even in the face of resistance from her husband. It is not always possible to know the final pregnancy outcome of all the patients True Care serves, but when we do, it is such a blessing. We are praising God for empowering this brave Mama to choose life for her precious daughter.

Which means in one year, more than 55,000 unborn lives have been saved. And while Wyoming's pro-life laws continue to sit in limbo, God is working! In response to a "Chelsea Fund" billboard campaign, True Care supporters gave nearly \$50,000 to help True Care ramp up our billboard advertising. Those funds were used to secure at least 2 billboards at a time around Casper for two years. Additionally, we were able to advertise in the movie theaters and on digital billboards as well.

Prince of Peace Lutheran Church provided funding for 200 blessing bags and a faithful donor then sent a check to cover 100 - \$10 gift cards for those

Our prayer room was in need of an upgrade and a local furniture company graciously donated beautiful furniture and decor, making our offices feel even

A family with a high-risk pregnancy was overwhelmed with love by supporters who gave funds and gas cards as well as a truck-load of Christmas gifts from Casper Christian School families.

During the holidays, the Knights of Columbus provided dozens of Thanksgiving and Christmas dinners to our patients and their families.

Nearly every week, blankets, diapers, and baby clothing are dropped off at True Care for our baby layettes. What a blessing to our new moms!

And when a protest was scheduled outside our center, we called on supporters to come and pray for God's presence in our building. More than 40 mighty prayer warriors showed up and prayed that day beforehand, double the number who actually came that evening to protest.

In 2022, God reminded me often of His servant Joshua. In fact, I still vividly remember the first sermon of 2022, in which Pastor Ed Tharp preached from Joshua 1. In the first 10 verses of the book of Joshua, God instructs him three times to be "strong and courageous." Three, a holy number. God placed those verses and that sermon in my life at the exact time I needed it and in the last year, He has shown Himself to be continually faithful and abundant in love.

VISION: Reaching the right women at the right time and serving them in the right way for the greatest possible gain on behalf of patients, babies, staff, donors, the organization, the community and God.


